Howard, CO 81233
14 Miles East of Salida, CO on HWY 50 or...
45 Miles West of Canon City, CO on HWY 50

On Site Camping:

Dry camping will be available at the event site starting Wednesday night. Camping is primitive with no water or electricity. Camping is in a field and there is no natural shade in the camping area. There will be portable toilets on site.

Fees:

- FREE to Spectators, no spectator bikes allowed during the event.
- NATC National Riders/Minders will have a \$20 per day land use fee per participant, \$40 total for weekend. Be prepared to pay at tech inspection.
- Camping is on public land and will be FREE of charge.

Additional Information:

- **Spark arrestors and Colorado Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) permits are required. PLEASE get your permits ahead of time: <https://cpw.state.co.us/buyapply/Pages/RegistrationsOHV.aspx>.**
- There will be a NextGen Mototrials Youth Event on Friday and Saturday for children 18 months through 13 years of age. AMA membership is required for all riders but the STRIDER class. NO ENTRY FEE! Friday: Sign in at 10:00am and Rider Meeting at 12:45pm and Saturday: Sign in at 9:00am and Rider Meeting at 10:15am. Sign up on site with Ben Eudy. - **The Turkey Rock Trials Area is restricted to trials motorcycles only, make sure any riding is done within the area boundaries**
- NO arriving before Wednesday. Practice area will be open starting Thursday morning.
- **Tech Inspection: Friday 3:00pm to 5:00pm and Saturday/Sunday 8:00am to 8:30am**
- NO generators between the hours of 10 pm to 7 am. If you require a generator overnight utilize nearby RV facilities.
- NO food vendors will be on site. Please plan accordingly.
- Dog must always be leashed. Please pickup after pet waste.
- Salida and Canon City will be the two larger towns for any needed supplies. Salida is approx. 20 minutes from trials site and Canon City is approx. 60 minutes from the trials site.

Hotels and Accommodation:

- **There are full hookup rv sites and lodging available very close by in Howard, Pleasant Valley RV Park (pleasandtvalleyrv.com), Black Bear Retreat (blackbearrvpark.com) and Sugarbush Campground (sugarbushco.com)**
- There are quite a few hotels and accommodation in Salida but we advise you book early.

Coming from East (Canon City)	Coming from West (Salida)
Turn R (Northeast) on CR 47 – go 0.3mi	Turn L (East) on Howard Creek Rd/CR 4 – go 0.5mi – turning right to stay on CR 4
Turn L (Northwest) on CR 45 (CAUTION! 11 ft clearance RR underpass) – go 1.3m	Turn R (South) on CR 45 – go 0.6mi
Turn R (East) – on Sand Rd – follow ribbon and signs to pit area ahead	Turn L (East) – on Sand Rd – follow ribbon and signs to pit area ahead
