Lettering Requirements for AMA / NATC National Participants

Participants not adhering to this criteria will not be allowed to start

The following specifications are required for participants who will compete in the NATC National Trials series in any class. It is the responsibility of the participant to provide a suitable Long-or-Short sleeved riding jersey properly lettered with their name on the back as described below.



LETTERING:

Any permanent type material is acceptable. i.e.: vinyl iron on, direct silk screen, sew on cloth, leather or embroidery. Legible lettering only. Color must provide contrast to the Long-or Short sleeved jersey.

SLEEVED JERSEY:

Any suitable Long-or-Short sleeved material or configuration consistent with motorcycle competition is required. All garments must pass inspection by the technical inspector and official starter.

ALL PARTICIPANTS:

If you have a minder for any national you will be required to pay their entry fee, be responsible for all their actions. Minders will be issued a bib at sign-up. The participant will be fined \$50.00 if the bib is returned intentionally defaced, and the bib will be retired.
